We apply the correct professional symbols when we redraw your plan.



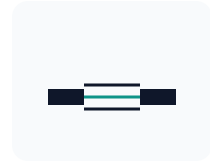
Walls

arc shows swing



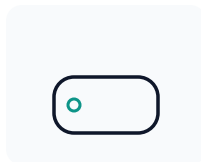
Window

in the wall



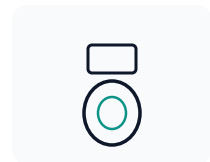
Stairs

direction arrow



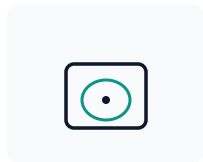
Bath

cooktop



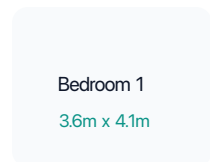
